# Fellowship for Peace & Learning

## **Selection Criteria**

Fellowship for Peace & Learning is a program to support meritorious girls from underprivileged strata of the society pursue college education. The program is open all over Bhartvarsh to students selected/enrolled in any government college.

- ► Fellowships will be awarded only to girls Below Poverty Line, selected in a government college, who are not eligible for any other funding / scholarship from any other source. Being from a BPL family should ordinarily be sufficient to receive the scholarship. However, in special cases where a candidate is exceptionally brilliant and her family is not able to support her studies (though not a BPL family), it may also be considered, at the discretion of the selection committee.
- ► The amount (Rs 10,000/student ± 50 %) will cover tuition fee + books. Selection of the students will be broadly based on their demonstration of -
  - ► Good academic achievement
  - ► Continued Significant financial need
- ► If a donor sponsors ≥ 10 fellowships, Princeton Foundation will allow the flexibility (e.g. named fellowships, flexibility in fellowship criteria for that specific cohort such as need based vs merit based, regional vs national, traditional vs vocational, specific vocation etc).
- ► Fellowships will be renewed annually based on academic performance (to be defined by the Selection Committee at the time of award of the first year scholarship). If she does not meet the criteria in any year, the fellowship will not be awarded, however, it may recommence from a subsequent year, if the criteria is met.
- ► Fellowship will be awarded only for the normal duration of the course, with or without breaks due to detention or voluntary skipping of a year.
- ▶ **Pay Forward:** All recipients are required to pledge that they will commence supporting at least 3 other girls to complete college / vocational education, within a time limit of 3 years after completing their own education. The Foundation would connect them to such deserving girls.
- ► Fellowship money will be deposited directly in the student's college account.

## **Application Material**

- Students can apply either directly at Application Fellowship for Peace and Learning
- Or submit their application the format provided on the next page
- Documents (Aadhar, BPL, academic records etc)
- A credible document to ascertain family income (not every family may be filing IT returns)
- Confirmation of selection to a government college.
- Recommendation and approval of the College Principal
