Policy Statement

The policy strives to evolve a well defined, fair and transparent framework for providing financial assistance to meritorious as well as poor and needy students with the purpose of encouraging and motivating the girl students to pursue Higher Education through scholarships and Fee Waiver.

Objectives:

- To support the students financially by helping them in applying for government scholarship (State and National).
- To communicate information about various non-government scholarships and to encourage the students and help them in applying for these scholarship.
- To ensure fair selection process for institutional scholarships
- To ensure timely disbursement of scholarships.

Process:

Scholarship Committee

A scholarship committee is to be formed at the college level to look after the distribution of scholarship to eligible candidate. The committee will work in cooperation with the Teacher Incharge of different departments. The composition of the committee will be as follows:

- **Convener** - a senior faculty member
- **Members**
 - Two faculty members (preferably one Associate Professor and One Assistant Professor)
 - One Non-teaching Staff

Role and Responsibilities of the Committee:

The committee has to ensure that

- Information about government, non-government and institutional scholarships is timely displayed on college notice board and is also shared by teachers in their respective classes.
- Students are provided all necessary assistance in applying for government and non-government scholarships.
- Teachers Incharges are provided with the list of different scholarships and selection criteria and have submitted the list of applicants to the committee timely.
- The forms are scrutinized fairly and after verification names of the eligible candidates are communicated to the respective departments.

The Principal shall be the final authority to approve the award of the scholarship.

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Criteria for Scholarship:

- Merit : good Academic performance & excellence in extracurricular activities
- Financial hardship

Documents Required:

Applicants have to submit the following documents:

- Educational Certificates (If selected for merit scholarships)
- Scanned copy of Bank passbook for Student's Bank Account Number, IFSC code of the bank and branch name.
- Documents to verify economic status of the student like Income Certificate of parents, Ration Card etc. (If selected for the scholarships for poor and needy students)
