Spread over an area of 300 acres in Rajghat, Varanasi, the college has a picturesque campus on the banks of river Ganga, and natural environment. The college has a good infrastructure & learning resources keeping in consonance its reputation as a famous Women's College of Varanasi. The college has 59 classrooms, 05 Labs, 03 Hostels; well equipped Library having its own ICT enabled Knowledge Centre, a separate Computer Lab for B.Ed., Playground, Gym, Auditorium, Canteen etc to facilitate proper learning & co-curricular activities of students leading to a holistic development of students. An internet facility with Wi-Fi connectivity has enhanced the e-learning capacity of students. The college has its transport facility having twelve buses for students and two cars.

In the KFI campus, the college has number of sister organization like School, Rural Centre, Sanjeevani Hospital, KFI Study Centre, Guest House, Dairy farm, etc. On the campus we have a Health Centre with two resident doctors and two nurses having twenty four beds with ambulance facility for emergency. Sanjeevani Hospital has X-Ray and Pathology facility etc. The campus has a separate Engineering Department maintained by Krishnamurti Foundation India. The department takes care of the Civil/Electrical and other day to day repairing and maintenance. The departments take care of their respective laboratory equipments. The equipments like

computer/photocopier/ AC/ Fridge, water cooler etc are maintained by giving AMC. There is a 24 bed health centre with ambulance facility, two resident Doctors and other paramedical staff working 24X7 hours and attend students' medical aid in case of emergency.

The girls of Vasantashram have been greatly appreciated during all events organized in the college. Girls have actively participated in all academic and co-curricular activities organized in

the hostels and then zeal and creativity in terms of decoration and presentation of program was outstanding. All activities were organized under the leadership of newly appointed managers. These activities include the Fresher, Induction Program, Janmashtami, Saraswati Puja and Farewell. NCC

In this session total 150 students were enrolled and more than 70 students were selected. Sixty students among them were selected for the NCC training programme. The cadets attended the Drill, Ceremonial Drill, Weapon Training, Personality Development and Leadership, Disaster Management, Social Services and Community Development, Environmental Awareness and Conservation, Map Reading etc. The cadets also participated in CATC Annual Camp at 28 UP Girls Bn, NCC, BHU. Guidance and Counseling Cell

In this session, almost 50+ girls registered and more than 150+ sessions were done. The sessions were mainly focusing on emotional health, social skills, career guidance, behavioural modification, family adjustment, social adjustment, relationship issues, and general every day stress. In October 2019, on World Mental Health Day, a seminar on Suicide Prevention was organized in association with Department of Psychology. A training workshop was also organized for girls in collaboration with Home Science Department.

Corporate Social Responsibility

A mega tree plantation drive was undertaken by the college on 16 July 2019 with the support of Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board, Varanasi. A large numbers of trees (Arjun) were planted along the bank of river Ganga to prevent soil erosion and a walking trail was also built. The college has received financial assistance for the same. The teachers have donated their publication for Institutional repository for our library. The Knowledge Center is equipped with 41 computers with INTERNET facility for the students. Three printers are available for the readers. The Teacher's & Research Scholar's Room is also equipped with 7 computers with Internet facility. The total collection of books in the library till 31st March 2019 is 44,362. The library has created Periodical Section and subscribed 42 Journals, 11 magazines and 11 newspapers. The text book and reference book sections are providing the books to the users for their academic work. Photocopy section is also there in the Library. The library subscribed NLIST service of INFLIBNET which offers online access to 6,000+ ejournals and 31,35,000+ ebooks. The college is also registered in National Digital Library of India which provides a single window search facilities to act as a one-stop shop for all digital resources.
